

# **Southern Water Guidance on Site Specific Arrangement for Sensitive Sites**

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## Objective

This document details Southern Water's (SWS), policy guidelines to retailers for setting up new site specific arrangements for non-household (NHH) sites.

## Procedure

When a customer requests (or a retailer identifies) a site that will require a site specific arrangement, initial guidance should be taken from '**Dealing with sensitive sites and other non-household customers in the event of a change in water or sewerage service**' document. The service provided to NHH customers, by the wholesaler, will be dependent on the NHH customer's categorisation. This categorisation is based on customer type and covered by service agreements and site specific plans.

Retail service providers may offer additional support to augment wholesaler provisions.

The following guidance is supplied for NHH categorisation;

Category	Description	Examples	SWS Response
NHH1	High dependency and/or high occupancy residential population where relocation would be problematic	Hospitals Prisons	Retailer to work with the wholesaler (using full SSA template) to produce site specific arrangement (SSA). SWS options include, tanker supplies direct into on-site mains / dedicated static tanks.
NHH2	Residential population	Care Homes Hospices Nursing Homes Sheltered Housing	Less comprehensive version of SSA (SSA Lite) compiled by retailer and submitted to the wholesaler to establish service depending on the quantity of water required.
NHH3	Non-residential but societal impact	Education facilities (Schools, Nurseries) Health Centres GP Surgeries Dentists Essential Food Industries Emergency Services	Consideration given to establishing SSA 'lite', compiled by retailer and submitted to the wholesaler or covered by ' <b>Dealing with sensitive sites and other non-household customers in the event of a change in water or sewerage service</b> '. Location of alternative water supplies would depend on local feasibility.
NHH4	Animal Use	Farms with livestock Zoos Vets Kennels / Catteries	See ' <b>Dealing with sensitive sites and other non-household customers in the event of a change in water or sewerage service</b> '.
NHH5	Critical national or local infrastructure	Airports Train/Bus Stations Motorway Services Hotels / Restaurants	See ' <b>Dealing with sensitive sites and other non-household customers in the event of a change in water or sewerage service</b> '.

Each category of NHH customer should have service provisions tailored to the specific needs of that category. These range from full bespoke site specific plans, reduced detail plans or specific alternative water arrangements.

For example;

**Site Specific Arrangement (SSA)** – pre-planned arrangements with customers to determine the level of service needed in the eventuality of a supply interruption/do-not drink or boil notice.

The retailer should consult with the wholesaler to produce a site specific arrangement for NHH1 using the SSA template provided in Appendix A.

**Site Specific Arrangement Lite (SSA Lite)** – a less detailed version of the SSA aimed at premises with lower impact of supply interruptions.

The retailer should consult with their customer to compile a lite version of the site specific arrangement using the SSA template provided in Appendix B.

Any completed forms should be submitted to your Retailer Relationship Manager. Southern Water will validate and if required discuss with you arrangement details or amendments.
