Rain – Essential for our water usage in the water cycle

Outfall - where cleaned wastewater empties into the sea

You – who uses the water?

Glacier - slow moving mass of solid water

Brine – water fully saturated by salt

Ice – frozen or solid form of water

Vapour – gas form of water

Run-Off – where unabsorbed or unevaporated rain collects; can cause erosion

Oil – washed down kitchen sinks, but hardens blocking pipes and causes pollution

Yellow – The colour of our body's wastewater

Gush – How Southern Water would like water to flow to everyone!

Blockage – When fat, oil, grease, wipes collect and restrict wastewater flow

Irrigation – the supply of water to land or crops

Vital – We can only live a few days without water!
