

**Collect those showers with a mini water butt**

**You will need –**

A large milk container and it's lid (4 or 6 pints)

Strong garden twine or garden string

Scissors, decorations, paint brush, glue



Rinse milk container and remove label.

Carefully cut off the bottle base, close to the bottom. Ask an adult to help, if needed.



Decorate the bottle, if required.  
Don't forget the bottle will be fixed upside down and the lid will be at the bottom.

Use the twine or string to securely attach the bottle to an outside fence, through the handle too and around lid base, with the lid on tight and facing downwards.  
Your mini-butts could get heavy with water.

When it rains, your mini waterbutts will collect rainwater. When you need to water your plants, place a watering can below the bottle lid and unscrew carefully.
